- **Preparation of the ECOFIN and Eurogroup meetings, 20-21 February 2017**

Vice-President **Dombrovskis** and Commissioner **Moscovici** will represent the European Commission at today's meeting of the Eurogroup and tomorrow's ECOFIN Council meeting. At the Eurogroup, ministers will hold a general discussion on the ease of doing business in the euro area. Based on the Commission's [Winter 2017 Economic Forecast](#) published on 13 February, ministers will also exchange views on the economic situation and policy challenges for the euro area. Ministers will then assess progress made on the second review of the stability support programme for Greece. The meeting will be followed by a press conference with Vice-President **Dombrovskis**.

- **EU-supported films won the Golden Bear and four Silver Bears at Berlinale**

Five films supported by the [Creative Europe MEDIA programme](#) won the Golden and Silver Bears at the 67th Berlin International Film Festival (Berlinale). The Hungarian film [Teströl és lélekröl](#) (On Body and Soul) directed by Ildikó Enyedi has received the Golden Bear for Best Film. Additional MEDIA-supported films received special awards: altogether 10 MEDIA-backed films won a total of 14 awards at Berlinale during this weekend. Altogether 25 films supported by the Creative Europe MEDIA programme participated in the Berlinale programme. - **European Commission calls for experts to join its Financial Services User Group**

The European Commission has today launched a [call for expression of interest](#) for new members of the [Financial Services User Group \(FSUG\)](#). The renewal of the Group is part of the Commission's efforts to give consumers a strong voice in the EU policy making in financial services. The Group will advise the Commission on its ongoing work on the Capital Markets Union, with a particular focus on the distribution of retail investment products. It will also weigh in on the

implementation of the Commission's forthcoming Retail Financial Services Action Plan. The deadline for submitting applications is 21 April 2017.

- **Eurostat: Consommation d'énergie en 2015 - La consommation d'énergie dans l'UE en-dessous de son niveau de 1990**

En 2015, la consommation intérieure brute d'énergie, qui reflète la quantité d'énergie nécessaire pour satisfaire l'ensemble de la consommation intérieure, s'est élevée dans l'Union européenne (UE) à 1 626 millions de tonnes équivalent pétrole (Mtep), soit un niveau inférieur à celui de 1990 (-2,5%) et en baisse de 11,6% par rapport à son pic de près de 1 840 Mtep relevé en 2006. Représentant près des trois quarts de la consommation d'énergie de l'UE en 2015, les combustibles fossiles étaient toujours, et de loin, la principale source d'énergie, même si leur poids n'a cessé de diminuer au cours des dernières décennies, passant de 83% en 1990 à 73% en 2015. Toutefois, au cours de cette période, la dépendance de l'UE vis-à-vis des importations de combustibles fossiles a augmenté, 73% étant importés en 2015 contre à peine plus de la moitié (53%) en 1990. En d'autres termes, tandis qu'en 1990, une tonne de combustibles fossiles était importée pour chaque tonne produite dans l'UE, en 2015, trois tonnes étaient importées pour chaque tonne produite.
